The Institute

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida Fundació Dr. Pifarré (IRBLleida) was established with the aim of creating synergies between basic, clinical and epidemiological research, making biomedical research a key driver to improve current clinical practice. IRBLleida covers a chain of translational research, from basic research, aimed at understanding the physiological and pathological mechanisms of the human body, to research that studies the behavior of diseases in large population groups.

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida (IRBLleida) was founded in 2004 through a cooperation agreement between the University of Lleida (UdL) and the Catalan Healthcare system. IRBLleida integrates research groups of the faculties of Medicine and Nursing and Physiotherapy of the UdL. On the other hand, we incorporate research groups from:

- 1. The Catalan Health Institute (ICS) both at the hospital level (Arnau de Vilanova University Hospital HUAV) and the primary healthcare of Lleida and the Alt Pirineu-Aran Health Region,
- 2. The healthcare provider <u>Gestió de Serveis Sanitaris</u> (<u>GSS</u>; <u>Santa María University Hospital</u> <u>HUSM</u>, <u>Pallars Regional Hospital</u> and <u>Mental Health</u>, among others).

IRBLleida has been a CERCA institute since 2013, and as such is organized according to a model of good governance and operation that ensures efficiency, management flexibility, talent recruitment and promotion, strategic planning and executive capacity. It is also one of the 34 Spanish Health Research Institute (IIIS) recognized by the Carlos III Health Institute and the Government of the Generalitat, as established by Law 16/2003, of 28 May, on the cohesion and quality of the national health system.

Context and tasks to be developed:

The person will join the Experimental Neuromuscular Pathology group of the IRBLleida, within the research line "Spinal muscular atrophy" as a Senior Laboratory Technician and will provide technical support to the development of the research project "Preclinical analysis of new combinatorial treatments for spinal muscular atrophy (SMA): effects where motoneuron survival, synaptic integrity, and skeletal shoulder preservation, File 202005-30-31-32", financed with funds raised by La Marató TV3 foundation, focused on the preclinical study of combinatorial therapies for spinal muscular atrophy using murine models of the disease.

Some of the tasks it will carry out include the following:

- Control and handling of rodents, and behavioural testing of motor activity.
- Extraction of tissue samples for histological studies.
- Preparation of reagents and solutions.
- Tissue processing for histological studies at light and electron microscopy level.
- Histochemical and immunocytochemical techniques.
- General cellular and molecular biology techniques and procedures.
- Cleaning and sterilisation of glassware.
- Waste management and disposal
- Management of purchases of reagents and laboratory consumables.
- Maintenance of laboratory equipment.

Express selection process
