

1. Programme Opening

1.1. Introduction

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida Fundació Dr. Pifarré (IRBLleida) was founded with the goal of fostering collaboration among basic, clinical, and epidemiological research, with the purpose of making biomedical research a catalyst for improving everyday clinical practices, benefiting the broader population. IRBLleida's mission is to advance, develop, transfer, oversee, and disseminate outstanding research, scientific, and technological knowledge. We believe that the capacity to nurture ground-breaking ideas and research is crucial in advancing healthcare and improving lives. In this context, we are glad to announce an open call to raise innovative ideas and advance them with working sessions, experts' input and collaborative discussion to submit more robust proposals to next year innovative competitive calls.

1.2. Summary

INNOVATION is a programme promoted by the Institut de Recerca Biomèdica de Lleida (IRBLleida) with the aim of supporting research teams in transforming scientific knowledge, ideas and identified unmet needs into innovation opportunities with potential for transfer and societal impact.

The first edition, **INNOVATION BENCH** programme is designed primarily for projects at **early stages of development**, particularly those with low Technology Readiness Levels (TRL 1–4), and seeks to provide participants with practical tools, methodologies and support to structure their ideas and prepare them for future competitive funding, collaboration, investment and/or transfer opportunities.

INNOVATION combines training, practical work on participants' own projects, feedback from the Innovation Unit and subject-matter experts and networking within the IRBLleida innovation ecosystem.

2. Programme Description

2.1. Scope

INNOVATION is intended to support ideas and projects arising from research and healthcare activity within the IRBLleida ecosystem, including, but not limited to:

- scientific or technological innovations;
- products and services;
- diagnostic or therapeutic approaches;
- medical devices and digital health solutions;

- innovations addressing clinical or healthcare process or organizational needs;
- other knowledge-based innovations with potential for transfer and impact.

The programme will focus **primarily on early-stage projects, particularly projects in TRL 1–4**. Projects at higher TRLs may be considered where participation in the programme is justified by the objectives and activities of the programme.

2.2. Funding & Payment

Participation in the programme is free of charge.

2.3. Duration & Important Dates

For the **2026 first BENCH edition**, the indicative programme calendar is:

3. Candidates profile

3.1. Eligibility

Candidates must be affiliated with IRBLeida prior to the proposal submission deadline and maintain their affiliation throughout the duration of the funded project.

3.2. Incompatibility

3.3. Additional considerations

To accommodate and facilitate the participation of the ideas in the programme, we allow (and **strongly recommend**) **the submission of the idea with the figure of a Project Leader and a co-Leader** so any of the two leading members (or both) can attend the working sessions and later advance with the idea based on the working session learnings.

4. Application & Award Decision

4.1. Proposal Submission

4.2. Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be assessed according to criteria aligned with the objectives of INNOVATION BENCH (low TRL and with transference potential) to ensure fruitful working sessions. Excluded projects will be offered alternative support programmes.

4.3. Award Decision

Applicants shall be informed no later than the 25th of September of the award decision by individual communication.

5. Beneficiaries' obligations

5.1. Project Follow-up

Selected participants shall:

- actively participate in the training and working sessions;
- comply with the timetable and deadlines established by the programme;
- dedicate the expected time to the development of their project;
- complete the practical assignments associated with the sessions;
- provide the Innovation Unit with the information reasonably required to provide feedback and support;
- participate in the final presentation or pitch, where applicable;
- use the tools and resources provided by the programme responsibly;
- respect the confidentiality of information shared by other participants and IRBLeida;
- comply with applicable IRBLeida policies and procedures concerning intellectual property, confidentiality, data protection and research integrity; and

- promptly inform the Innovation Unit of any circumstance that may materially affect the development or eligibility of the project.

Participants shall be responsible for ensuring that any information they share during the programme can legitimately be disclosed.

The programme is intended to provide a safe environment for constructive exchange, and participants are encouraged to share their ideas sufficiently to benefit from feedback and collaboration. However, participants must take appropriate precautions where disclosure could compromise intellectual property, confidentiality or contractual obligations.

Participation in the programme does not replace the formal procedures established by IRBLeida for the disclosure, assessment or protection of intellectual property.
