## SHORT BIO

Dr. Tura-Ceide is a researcher Miguel Servet type with a consolidated research experience of over 15 years in the field of angiogenesis, endothelial dysfunction, and stem cells in pulmonary and cardiovascular diseases. Dr. Tura-Ceide did her Ph.D. in stem cell biology at the University of Edinburgh, UK (2007). Her postdoctoral training continued at the MRC Centre for Regenerative Medicine, Edinburgh focused on the identification of the origin of endothelial stem cells and to assess its regenerative potential using induced pluripotent stem cells. In 2013, Dr. Tura-Ceide received a Marie Curie postdoctoral fellowship and moved to the Biomedical Research Institute, IDIBAPS, Barcelona with the aim of applying in the field of respiratory diseases, the knowledge and skills gathered in endothelial cell biology. Since then, her line of research has obtained continued funding through several competitive national and international calls. Dr. Tura-Ceide has experience of over 11 years working abroad and a total of 63 publications in the field of cardiopulmonary diseases, and 2 patents on the discovery of a new polymer that specifically promoted both endothelial stem cell growth. She has directed several Ph.D. and master theses. Dr. Tura-Ceide has participated in numerous international and national conferences, has active collaborations internationally and within Spain, and is an evaluator/reviewer of several national or international committees. Since 2017, Dr. Tura-Ceide is an associate professor at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Girona, Spain, and professor of three international master's degrees at the University of Barcelona, UB.
